

Beaverlodge Track Rules



1. Race gate opens at 8:30 am and closes at 11:00 pm.
2. Wristbands **MUST** be worn at all times and are not transferable.
3. No pit vehicle use after 10 p.m. except by track staff for set-up or security.
4. Drivers of **any motorized** vehicle (excluding Junior Dragsters) must hold a valid driver's license.
5. All children under the age of 8 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult at all times.
6. Maximum speed in the pit area is 10 km/hr.
7. A person must be in the car at all times while it is running. When running in gear, the rear axle must be on 2 stands supported by plywood and the driver must be in the car.
8. Absolutely no motorized vehicles, except track staff and racers for the duration of their run, are allowed on the track.
9. Current tech sticker is required on the window of all race vehicles.
10. No one is permitted near the timing bus at any time. Concerns will be handled by the Race Captain.
11. There must be proper seats, helmets and restraints for drivers and passengers (same as what is required of the driver) during staging and prior to racing.
12. Electronic devices (i.e. delay boxes/throttle stops) are permitted only in the Box Class.
13. No burnouts, spinning, or stunting in the pit, staging or camping areas. Immediate eviction from the facility.
14. No passengers are permitted during eliminations.
15. No riding on top of or outside of vehicles.
16. Dial in and car numbers must be displayed on the left side window and the right front windshield in bold white lettering. No other colour will be accepted.
17. If you are deep staging you must have 'DEEP' on your windshield.
18. Side windows must be rolled up during staging.

19. Gentlemen staging in effect. (Wait for your opponent to pre-stage before staging.)
20. No holding vehicles during a burnout.
21. Do not back up after burnouts unless you are out of shape and must straighten.
22. All race matches are by random line up.
23. Only 1 'bye' run per day. 'Bye' runs must be taken. The only way you can be disqualified in a 'bye' run is to cross the centre line.
24. Crossing the centre line will result in immediate disqualification from the remainder of the weekend.
25. Lane choice is up to the drivers. If a dispute arises it will be settled by a coin toss.
26. The number of time trials allotted will depend on the number of vehicles and time permitting. A maximum of three time trials per day will be monitored by the timing bus.
27. Please proceed to the return lane promptly.
28. Come to a **complete stop** when picking up your time slip.
29. Return on the pit side of the track.
30. Entry fees will be refunded only if NO runs were made. If you trip the lights it is considered a run.
31. Grassed areas can be very dry so please be aware of fire safety on the grounds.
32. Please show courtesy and consideration for your fellow participants and campers. i.e. loud music, parking space, cleanliness
33. **Pets** are allowed in the **camping area only** and must be kept on a leash at all times. Absolutely **no pets** are allowed on the **track or spectator side** of the event at any time.
34. Smoking is permitted in the camping area and designated areas only. Please dispose of your butts properly.
35. Absolutely no alcohol is permitted while the race lights are up. Anyone found not following this rule will be automatically disqualified and may be asked to leave.
